Q: Why was the baby in Egypt?

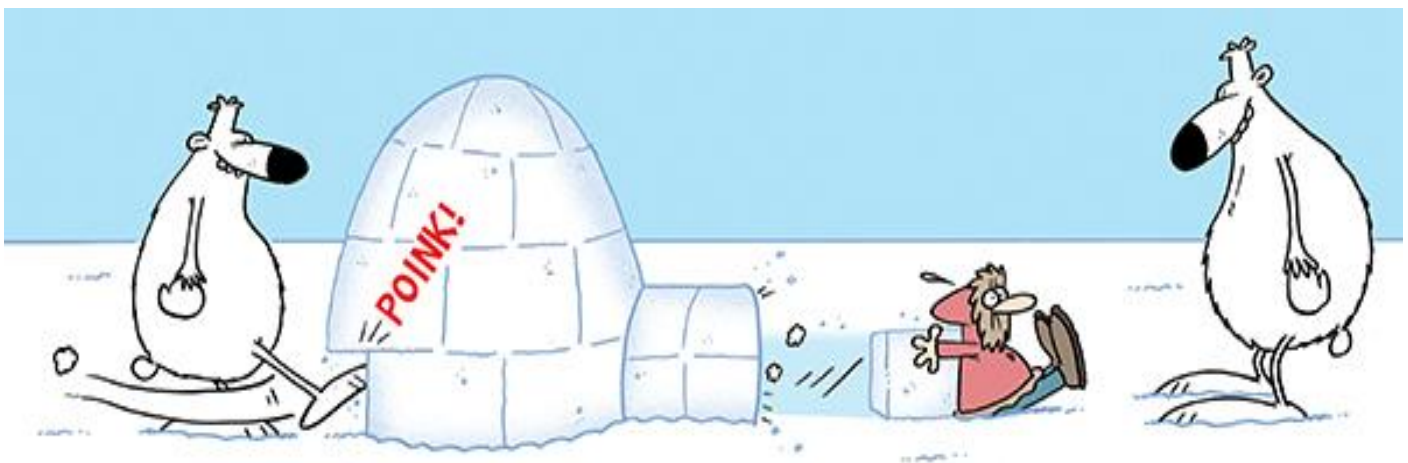
