## **Program:** The January Program will be about **The Iron Canyon Fish Passage Project**.

It will remove a fish passage barrier blocking an adromous fish from accessing Big Chico Creek above Salmon Hole. The results will help increase populations of native fish, including steelhead trout and spring-run Chinook Salmon in Big Chico Creek. This project will result in a healthier, more biodiverse creek that will benefit both the environment and our community.

The speaker will be **Danielle Feulner** who is the Community Engagement Specialist for Chico State's Big Chico Creek Ecological Reserve (BCCER). She's a Chico native and a Chico State Alumni who grew up playing in Bidwell Park. She's been working on spreading the word about an exciting project in Upper Park: the Iron Canyon Fish Passage Project.


## SIR 110 Activities
