50 Years Ago On August 6, 1972, Hank Aaron hit his 660th and 661st

home runs for the Atlanta Braves, breaking Babe Ruth's MLB record of homers **for one team.** In 1974, he bettered Babe Ruth's home run record with his 715<sup>th</sup> home run and ended his career with 755 home runs. He held that record for 33 years until Barry Bonds hit his 756<sup>th</sup> home run on August 7, 2007.

Aaron played 21 seasons for the Milwaukee and Atlanta Braves (1954-1974) and 2 final years for the Milwaukee Brewers as a right fielder and a star hitter. Aaron continues to hold the record for the most seasons as an All Star (21). He died January 22, 2021 (aged 86) in Atlanta, Georgia.
