

## FRANKLIN HERBERT ZEBLEY III

Franklin H. "Trip" Zebley, age 77, died peacefully at home on September 9, 2023. He was born December 15, 1945, in Upland, California, the son of Franklin Herbert Zebley II and Alta Patricia Zebley Bowen. Frank was a graduate of Upland High School, class of 1963.
